The Mary Rose is a Tudor ship, built in 1510. In service for 34 years. Sank in 1545. Discovered in 1971. Raised in 1982. Now in the final stages of conservation, she takes her place in a stunning and unique museum. The archaeology and conservation work carried out at the Mary Rose was groundbreaking, contributing to the creation of both the Nautical Archaeological Society and the underwater archaeology section of the Institute of Field Archaeologists.
